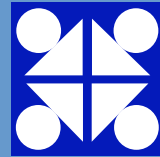

The mission of Family Support & Resource Center is to make it possible for Dane County children and youth with disabilities to live at home with their families as valued and participating members of the community.

We work in partnership with parents to enhance the caregiving capacity of families and the Dane County community. Our programs offer case management, financial assistance, information, and advocacy through services that are individualized, flexible, and designed to respond to family needs and preferences.

We are guided by these principles:

- Each family and child is unique.
- All children benefit by growing up as a secure member of a family and sharing in positive, long-term relationships with other family members.
- Families have great capacity to care for their children when they receive support from friends, neighbors, human service professionals, and other community members.
- Parents are generally in the best position to know their own needs, to find solutions, and to choose the kinds of services that will help them to care for their child with a disability.

- It is important to establish and preserve continuity of support with each family.
- Communities are enriched when all people are valued and included as full members.

WHAT HELP IS PROVIDED?

FSRC staff work with families to:

- Understand and gain access to available resources
- Coordinate supports, advocate on behalf of their child, and facilitate teamwork and problem-solving
- Purchase needed goods and services not available through other funding sources
- Help families to build and strengthen, encourage friendships for their children, and plan for the future

WHAT CAN FAMILIES PURCHASE?

Financial assistance is flexible and individually tailored to the needs of each family. Children's Long Term Support (CLTS) funds can be used to purchase architectural modifications, child care, daily living skills and parent training, equipment, respite and other expenses related to the care of their child with a disability. Funds may be used only when no other funding is available.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Families are eligible for services if they have a child under 18 years of age, who has a significant disability and is living at home in Dane County or returning from living out of home.

HOW DO I APPLY FOR SERVICES?

Start by contacting Dane County CLTS Intake at 608-242-6226 or cclsintake@countyofdane.com, to make an eligibility referral for CLTS Waiver. Your child will be placed on the CLTS wait list if found functionally eligible.

HOW SOON CAN I RECEIVE SERVICES?

There may be a waiting list for services.

HOW IS THE AGENCY GOVERNED & FUNDED?

FSRC is a private, non-profit corporation, governed by a volunteer Board of Directors made up of parents of children with disabilities, human service professionals, and interested community members.

Financial support is provided through the State of Wisconsin, United Way of Dane County and a variety of community businesses, foundations and individual donors. Gifts of any amount are appreciated and are tax deductible.
